Dear Leader McConnell, Speaker Pelosi, Leader Schumer, and Leader McCarthy:

I write to you today on behalf of the National Association of Federally-Insured Credit Unions (NAFCU) to express our support for Congressional efforts to provide additional funding to the Small Business Administration's (SBA) Paycheck Protection Program (PPP). As you are aware, credit unions are working on the front lines with their members during these times of economic uncertainty. NAFCU advocates for all federally-insured not-for-profit credit unions that, in turn, serve 120 million consumers with personal and small business financial service products.

Credit unions appreciate that they were included as lenders under the PPP program. Many credit unions are still familiarizing themselves with the details of the program and we are engaging with the SBA on the issues that have arisen thus far. As you consider additional funding for the PPP, it is important that a portion of any additional funds be set aside for community financial institutions such as credit unions so that they can assist their members and meet their needs. We support broad access for these programs and we do not want credit union members to be left behind. Credit unions have a strong record of being engaged in underserved areas and can help to stabilize these communities during this difficult time.

We thank you for the opportunity to share our thoughts and look forward to continuing to work with you on pandemic relief and economic recovery.
